Note 1: The candidates should note that, **Date of Birth** as recorded in the 10th Standard/Matriculation/Secondary Examination Certificate or an equivalent certificate submitted along with the application will only be accepted.

Note 2: The candidates should also note that, once the Date of Birth as has been claimed by them and entered in the records of the Administration, no change will be allowed subsequently on any grounds whatsoever.

3. **RESERVATION:** No post is exclusively reserved for any community such as SC/ST/OBC.

4. **PERIOD OF RECKONING SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS:**

For recruitment against this notification recognized sports achievements should be in the current and or immediate previous two financial years and sports persons shall be an active player i.e. the sports achievements being considered shall be on or after 01.04.2019. For validity of the sports achievement, concluding day of championship/event shall be taken into account. Further, activeness in sports will be adjudged as per his performance during the trials.

Only the current Annual All India Ranking shall be considered for these purposes. **For the purpose the highest ranking may be considered valid for one year for the purpose recruitment. Ranking in Mixed Doubles shall be considered only in Badminton and not in Table Tennis.**

- v) **In Cricket (Women) at International level**, if a Cricket player represented Main Indian Seniors Team (Women) atleast in Five Test Matches or in Ten Limited Overs One Day International matches may be considered for recruitment against the posts having Grade Pay Rs. 2800/2400 in Pay Band – I (Level-5/4 of Pay Matrix in VII CPC).

All the recruitments shall be at the minimum of scale of Pay.

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All the championships mentioned above, conducted under the aegis of recognized International/National/State Sports Federation and also recognized by the Railway Sports Promotion Board will only be acceptable.

Sportspersons having sports norms for higher Levels of pay and apply against the vacancies for the lower Levels of pay, will also be considered, provided he will not claim for higher Level after joining the Railways on the basis of sports achievements prior to joining Railways and the candidate gives an undertaking to this effect.

6. (I) SELECTION PROCEDURE:

- i) For this Recruitment, all eligible candidates will be called for the trials. Trials of the eligible candidates shall be conducted to assess the sports performance and suitability.
- ii) The dates for trials will be notified later and published in the South Western Railway website and will be held at Hubballi/Bengaluru/Mysuru or at notified place. While all out efforts will be made to inform the candidates well in advance, the candidates are cautioned that they may have to appear in the selection trials at short notice. The candidates are advised to regularly check the website for information in this regard.
- iii) Candidates should note that they are required to produce the originals of all documents uploaded while filling online application pertaining to educational qualification, caste, sports achievements, date of birth, minority income certificate and proof of identity viz. PAN card, Aadhar Card, Driving Licence etc. on the day of document verification and on the day trials failing which, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the trials.
- iv) South Western Railway will upload the list of eligible candidates selected for trials in South Western Railway website www.rchubli.in In addition, communication will also be sent by SMS/Email id as shown in the application, to the eligible candidates for appearing in the selection trials.
- v) Any request for change in dates/venue for trials etc **shall not be entertained** under any circumstances.

(II) Distribution of Marks:

- (a) Trial Committee shall give its recommendation in terms of either FIT or NOT FIT, for consideration for next stage, by giving marks (maximum 40 marks), as per the criteria given below:

- (b) After the trials, only the FIT candidates will be considered for the next stage. Candidates declared "NOT FIT" in the trials will not be assessed by the Recruitment Committee.

Note: The offer of appointment shall be given purely on the basis of merit. In case more than one sportspersons score the same marks, preference will be given to younger candidate to decide the merit.

7. PROCESSING FEE AND HOW TO MAKE FEE PAYMENT ONLINE:

(a)	The Processing Fee for all candidates except those mentioned in para (b) below.	Rs.500/- (Five Hundred only) with a provision for refunding Rs.400/- to those who actually appear in the trials.
(b)	For candidates belonging to SC/ST, Minorities and Economically Backward Classes.	Rs.250/- (Two Hundred and Fifty only) with a provision for refunding the same to those who actually appear in the trials.

Note:

- i) The Processing Fee should be paid ONLINE using internet banking or debit/credit cards (service charges apply for all banks which shall be borne by the candidates).
- ii) The Processing Fee is not refundable/transferable/adjustable under any circumstances, in respect of those candidates who do not fulfil the eligibility criteria but still have applied for recruitment, in response to this notification.
- iii) Certificate in proof of para 7 (b) above, issued by the authorities authorized to issue such certificate should be uploaded while filling the online application form for getting relaxation in the Processing Fee. Candidates should check their eligibility thoroughly before applying. Processing Fee paid in respect of candidates who are ineligible, but still apply, shall not be refunded.
- iv) While applying online, the candidates claiming Processing Fee exemption must upload necessary certificates i.e. SC/ST ('Annexure - A')/Minorities ('Annexure - C')/Economically Backward classes ('Annexure - D'), in the format prescribed.
- v) Online applications without necessary Processing Fee will be summarily rejected.
- vi) Minorities will mean Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jain and Zorastrains (Parsis).
- vii) Economically Backward classes (EBCs) will mean those candidates whose annual family income is less than Rs.50,000/-
- viii) The following authorities are authorized to issue income certificate for the purpose of identifying EBCs.
 - (a) District Magistrate or any other Revenue Officer up to the level of Tahasildar.
 - (b) Sitting Member of Parliament of Lok Sabha for persons of their own constituency.

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- (c) BPL card or any other certificate issued by the Central Government under a recognized poverty alleviation programme or Izzat MST issued by Railways.
- (d) Union Minister may also recommend for any persons from anywhere in the Country,
- (e) Sitting Members of Parliament of Rajya Sabha for persons of the district in which these MPs normally reside.
- (f) The income certificate issued by the authorities mentioned above would have to be in the format prescribed at 'Annexure - D'. This would have to be issued on the letter head of the issuing authority.

8. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

The sportsperson/s selected shall fulfil the minimum medical norms for the post, for which they are being appointed.

9. "SERVICE BOND" FOR PERSONS RECRUITED AGAINST SPORTS QUOTA:

The "Service Bond" period for the persons recruited against Sports Quota shall be of five years. At the time of his appointment, the sports persons shall fill and sign the Bond in the format as at 'Annexure - E' to this notification. In terms of provision of para 3 of 'Annexure - E' (Service Bond) those recruited against sports quota can participate in any of the sports activities other than those of the Government including professional Games/Leagues only with previous sanction of the Government.

10. HOW TO APPLY ONLINE/STEPS TO SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATIONS:

- (a) Stages of submission of ONLINE APPLICATION is of FOUR stages:
 - (a) Registration.
 - (b) Personal Details/Education Qualification/Sports Achievement.
 - (c) Upload Photo/signature/certificates of Education Qualification/Sports achievement, community certificate, No Objection Certificate, Self declaration by Minority candidate, etc.
 - (d) Payment of processing fees.
- (b) Visit the website: www.rrchubli.in \implies **Recruitment against Sports Quota (OA) for the year 2021-22.**
- (c) Candidates can view and download detailed notification available in the web page before applying.
- (d) Click on the "**ONLINE APPLICATION**" for **Sports Quota (Open Advertisement) recruitment for the year 2021-22**" link.
- (e) Click on the "**New Registration**".
- (f) Candidates will be redirected to **Registration page** wherein they have to enter Name, valid mobile number, E-Mail ID. Enter the OTP received and click on "SUBMIT".
- (g) An User ID & password will be sent to the registered provided mobile number, E-Mail ID which has to be preserved till the finalisation of selection process.
- (h) Candidates will be directed to login page wherein the User ID & Password has to be entered for submission of application.

- (i) Fill in the details i.e. address, community (SC/ST/OBC/UR), if belongs to Minority/Economically Backward Class, Educational Qualification, Sports achievement.
- (j) In next page candidate has to upload recent colour photograph of size 3.5 cm X 3.5cm (not older than three months from the date of application) with clear front view of the candidate without cap and sunglasses should be uploaded. The photo should be only in JPEG format, upload specimen signature as per the specifications mentioned in the website.
- (k) Also upload the following certificates:
 - (i) Certificate in support of Date of Birth.
 - (ii) All the required educational certificates (in one PDF).
 - (iii) Sports achievements certificates for the period between 01.04.2019 and 11.02.2022 (All sports achievement certificates are to be uploaded in one PDF) as per the specifications mentioned in the notification.
 - (iv) Community certificate/Self declaration of Minority candidates/ECB/NOC, etc.
- (j) After uploading submit after which all the details entered/uploaded by the candidates will be displayed. If there are any changes to be made, candidates can click on "EDIT" button to complete the changes or they can process for payment by clicking "Payment of fees".
- (k) After successful payment of processing fee an acknowledgement receipt will be displayed, which can be downloaded and take printout of the application form submitted. A copy of the same will be sent to registered email ID which can be preserved by the candidate for future reference.
- (l) Candidate may login at any stage for completing the submission process of online application after getting registered by clicking "Existing User Login" in the home page.

13. INVALID APPLICATIONS:

- (i) Application without scanned Photo.
- (ii) Applications without proof of age i.e. Date of Birth as recorded in the Birth certificate.
- (iii) Applications of over-aged and under-aged candidates as on the cut-off date and also where Date of Birth certificates uploaded are illegible, date not filled in or wrongly filled.
- (iv) Not having the requisite Educational Qualification as on the date of issue of notification.
- (v) Application without Caste Certificate/self declaration by minority candidates/ECB, etc. wherever fee relaxation is claimed in case of SC/ST/Minority/ECB candidates.
- (vi) Application without uploading the requisite certificates for eligibility.
- (vii) Applications which are incomplete in any manner, including non-filling up of requisite fields, etc.
- (viii) Any other form of irregularities as observed and considered as invalid.
